2005 Adelaide National Championships

A strong fleet of 52 boats competed in the 43rd Flying Fifteen National Championships held at Adelaide in January. Hosted by the newly formed South Australian Flying Fifteen Association and the Adelaide Sailing Club on Holdfast Bay in Adelaide, the Championships provided a wide range of open water sailing conditions.

Despite race conditions varying from absolute drifters to stiff 25-knot winds the Adelaide setting provided an ideal venue for the east and west coast fleets to meet. Again the Western Australian boats dominated the fleet, however, with visiting boats from New Zealand, England and Scotland competing an international flavour was added to the event.

Consistent strong winds from the southwest several days before the start of the competition looked promising for a strong weather series. Building southwesterlies create a strong swell in Holdfast Bay providing plenty of opportunities for the Flying Fifteens to surf on the downward legs.

However these conditions were not to be and lighter, more variable conditions persisted for most of the Championship.

The invitation race was typical of this light weather pattern. The race was sailed in a 5 to 10 knot southwesterly, with a residual sloppy chop from the previous day's strong winds. The race was won by Escalator from Western Australia, sailed by former World

Champion Graeme Lillingston and crew Ed Repsevicius, who was championship crew from the 2004 Championships in Tin Can Bay, Queensland.

With the Invitation Race out of the way the fleet was anxious to commence the Championship proper. An early morning view of the race area and the forecast for light winds indicated that conditions might favour the lighter crews. Bad news though, the sea breeze was so light that it failed to make any impression at all. Races were postponed at 12.30pm, finally being abandoned at 4pm. The next day forecast was for strong northerlies ahead of a southwest change. The Race Committee scheduled three races backto-back the next day, commencing at 11am. The forecast was spot on for the first three races. Hot northerlies steadily building before fading in the afternoon made for two short courses for Races 1 and 2. Ron Packer and Peter Mudford sailing Affrodisiac took out Race 1, with Nick Jerwood and Richard Rowell sailing Spot the Difference winning Race 2. The northerly wind began to fade for Race 3 and the shortened course flag was brought out. Nick Jerwood and Richard Rowell recorded the win in this race.

Three races were again scheduled for the third day. The south westerly change had come through and a nice 10 – 15 knot breeze provided plenty of anticipation as the fleet headed out for a 1.00 pm start. It was a No Bull day. Western Australians Grant Alderson and Dean McAullay sailing No Bull posted two first placings, in Races 4 and 5, with a third in Race 6.

Flying Fifteen

A strong fleet of 51 boats competed in the 43rd Flying Fifteen Australian championships hosted by the newly formed SA Flying Fifteen association and the Adelaide Sailing Club on Holdfast Bay.

Race conditions varied from absolute drifters to stiff 25kt winds. Western Australian boats dominated the fleet, while visitors from New Zealand,

England and Scotland added an international flavour to the event.

Light winds led to the postponement of racing on the first day. On day two the first three races were sailed in a hot northerly which faded during the afternoon. A south-westerly change came through for the three races on day three, while two races on the next day provided some frustrating and variable conditions.

A strong and building south-westerly of over 25kts produced some exhilarating racing in the final day's heat nine, won by Aaron Goodmanson and Alister Rowlands of New Zealand.

Overall winners of the championship and the Coweslip Trophy were Grant Alderson and Dean McAullay from Perth, followed by fellow Western Australians Ron Packer/Peter Mudford and Nick Jerwood/Richard Rowell.

The Silver division was won by Adele Frean and Travis Burtenshaw (WA), while Ian Lane and Daryl Langdon won the Classic division.

Next years' nationals will be hosted by the Canberra Yacht Club on Lake Burley Griffin.


