WINGS - "Dunnit" at last!

The Corporate Express 44th Australian Championships for the International Flying Fifteen class held in Canberra in January 2006 will proudly go on the records as won by experienced Canberrans John Tracey and Craig Murphy in 'Wings'.

John Tracey bought his boat from its Queensland owners several months before the series and took every possible opportunity available to practice in all conditions through winter and spring, and to fiddle, trim and tune the yacht. Prophetically, the well-campaigned boat was previously named 'Gun N Dunnit' and in earlier years the quick white boat was a major aggressor in the Victorian fleet, being very competitive in several earlier national championships before finally Tracey and Murphy 'Gun N Dunnit' in 2006.

Local Fifteeners have tried without luck for decades to wrest this coveted title from the Victorians and West Australians who have traditionally dominated the results since the very beginning of this class of international keelboat racing. Past CYC club champions Rod Dalgleish and Jim Howell almost succeeded in Canberra 1981/1982 but were thwarted by the WA past national champion Graeme Lillingston. By a fateful twist of fortune, nine time winner Graeme was to find himself the runner up here at the Canberra Yacht Club twenty-five years later.

Thirty-seven entrants competed in the nine races of the Corporate Express sponsored series on Lake Burley Griffin. Eight of the interstate yachts travelled from Perth, Adelaide, and North Queensland, and these numbers were swelled by a large contingent of 12 Victorian yachts, all eager to run off with the historic valuable silverware, the Coweslip Trophy, dating from the early sixties. Entrants included well-credentialed sailors and past winners such as Craig and Ian Rainey, the evergreen class patriarch Bill Shand, multi winner Graeme Lillingston, and the hot Peter 'Muddy' Mudford crewing for the very competitive sandgroper Rupert Leslie. All appreciated the strong support of Horizon Sailmakers for the series, none more so than John Wilson, the lucky WA winner of the complete suit of sails, presented by our friendly Victorian sailmaking competitor Brian Carroll on behalf of Horizon.

Our CYC Tracey/Murphy combination was expected to be hard pressed by locals John Hosking and Mat Gleeson, closely followed by the potentially competitive Colin Brown, Graham Giles, Peter Forster, and the tenacious Peter Harvey. Peter and Phil Russell were expected to feature well as was Tom Ruut. The local fleet supported the series in fine spirit by entering seventeen Canberra boats, many brandishing their new sails from Horizon, Gail and Rimmington or Pinnell and Bax.

After an easy Invitation Race on 9th January (won by Graeme Lillingston, for the 5th time), many of the interstate sailors initially struggled to come to grips with the light and shifty conditions experienced in the three races sailed on the first
