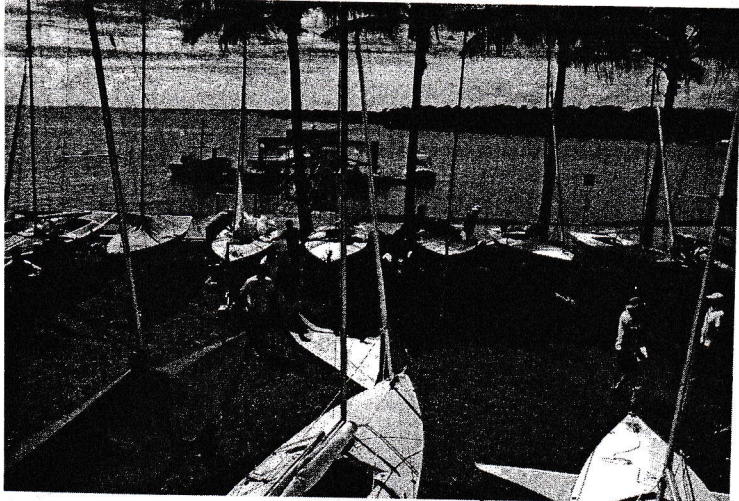
Well what a busy couple of months it has been for the members of Sandgate Yacht Club in the preparations and conducting of the Australian Flying Fifteen Sailing Championships.

On 6th December, 2009, the 5th and 6th heats of the Club Championships were sailed in a 20-knot North-East breeze. I will report on this race in the next issue of Boat Talk. On 20th December, 2009, boats were heading out of Cabbage Creek for the Christmas Race when a fierce electrical storm struck and the Starter, John Mitchell, wisely cancelled racing for the day. The upside of the day was that it rained all afternoon and Commodore Andrew Pearson, like all Scouts, was well prepared and fertilized the dead grass which turned into a luscious green lawn a week later - just in time for the arrival of our first visitors.

During the week commencing Monday, 28th December, 2009, lawns were mowed including the Brownseas Scouts yard, and hardstand allocation numbers were sprayed on the lawn. Cleaning was carried out to the Club and Brownseas Scout premises as well as removing coconuts and branches from trees. All was in readiness for the 42 entries which were received for the Australian Championships.

This is the largest number of entries for an Australian Championships conducted by Sandgate Yacht Club since the 1975-1976 season when 61 boats competed for the Lightweight Sharpie National Championship (won by a boat called "Ostara" from New South Wales and skippered by an ex Queenslander, the famous Edgar Roe).

David Reynolds should have been awarded "The Travellers Trophy" as, at the age of 72 years, he towed the boat he was crewing on ("Just Add Water") single handed from Geraldton in Western Australia. He had a few stories to tell of his adventure, like telling me he took the wrong turn and ended up in Queen Street, Melbourne, when in actual fact he was in Brisbane!



All measuring and safety checks were carried out on 31st December, 2009, and 1st January, 2010, by measurers Ron Godwin, Ashley Smith and John Grimmett with the assistance of Josh McAndrew and Ken Godwin. (Thanks guys for your contribution.)

On Saturday, 2-1-2010, the Invitation Race was sailed with a starting time of 11.30 am after a briefing at 9 am by Commodore Andrew Pearson with a PowerPoint presentation. (Visitors commented that it was conducted in a very professional manner - thanks Andrew).

The Invitation race was sailed in a 15 knot East-North East Breeze with the race being won by "I'd Swap This For A Bundy" skippered by Adam Hawkins and crewed by Ben Jones from Victoria while second was "16" David Tucker and Matthew Summers from Western Australia. The best placed Queensland boat was "Five Star" Adam Kingston and David Hows who finished fourth. Other Queensland boats in the first 20 were "Soggy Sox" 11th, "FAB" 13th, "Bubbles" 14th, "Ghost Magic" 15th, and "Think Big" 19th.

On Sunday, 3rd January, 2010, the first and second heats of the Championships were sailed in light winds. In the second heat, the race had to be shortened because of an impending storm.

The first four places in Heats 1 and 2 are as follows:

After the first two heats, the above four boats were all even on 5 points each. Congratulations were in order for the two heat winners as "FAB" won by a convincing margin and Bill Shand (the oldest competitor at 80 years) of age was a popular winner.

Bill said it was such an adrenalin rush: it was like winning his first Australian Flying Fifteen Championship back in sailing season 1968-1969.

On Monday, 4th January, 2010, there was a strong wind warning current with gusts of 28 knots recorded early in the morning at the Brisbane Airport. Starter John Mitchell and the sailing Committee judiciously cancelled racing for the day. In other parts of the Bay they raced and recorded gusts up to 27 knots with many retirements, broken masts and six broken rudder gudgeons. (This information is for those who were critical of the decision not to race.)

On Tuesday, 5th January, 2010, the breeze had abated and the third and fourth heats were sailed in 18-20 Knot South-Easter. The placings were as follows:

More from Sandgate Yacht Club and the 48th Australian Flying Fifteen Championship.

After six heats "16" could not be beaten on points for The Championship but still elected to sail in the seventh heat which was sailed in a 10 - 12 knot East-South Easter on Thursday, 7th January, 2010. Placings were as follows:
