Flying Fifteen 2019 Australian National Championships at RSAYS Adelaide

Day 1



The Flying 15 Nationals are now underway at the Royal South Australian Yacht Squadron. 28 boats are competing in the championships with boats from Western Australia, South Australia, Victoria and Queensland. Weather predictions for Gulf St Vincent were for warm weather with a SE breeze building from 10 kts to a breezy 20 kts by late afternoon.

Race 1 started with a good steady breeze of 10 knots which built to about 14 by the end of the race. The fleet were keen for a good

start with three boats over the line and one late starter. The boats over the line did not return. The course was two laps windward and return. The racing was close with the fleet remaining fairly close for the entire race, with the exception of the late starter. 'Aussie Falcon' Dale Collings and Wayne Fallows (MSC/DBYC) was the only retirement for the race, with a broken stay. The results for Race 1 saw 'Where the Bloody Hell Are You' skippered by Craig Rainey and crewed by lan Rainey (GLYC) finish first. She came in ahead of



'Ineffable' Nick and Enfys Jerwood, (SoPYC) by 12 seconds and finishing third was 'Tuffan Up' David Yu and Chris Nelson, (RFBYC), 15 seconds behind the winner.



Race 2 started in slightly stronger breeze and increasing chop. The same course was set as for race 1. The start was good except for two boats over the line, "Fflashpoint" Peter Rooke, (SoPYC) and "She Who Must Be Obeyed" John Hassen, (SoPYC).

As the wind strength and wave height increased, the fleet started to spread out and the racing was not as close as the first race. The first three boats to finish were 'Ark' David Tabb and Dave Bennett, 'Ineffable'

Nick and Enfys Jerwood, (SOPYC) and Surprize by Giveraus skippered Stephen Fries, (SYC). Just missing a podium finish by 3 seconds was 'The Flying Flamingo' Lewis Davies and John Radnell (DBYC).

Nick Jerwood and crew Enfys Jerwood currently lead the regatta. Nick has won two Australian Championships and two World Championships (and is the current world runner-up). The regatta runs from 31st December to 5th January and race results can be found below

Day 2 of the Flying 15 National Championships at the Royal South Australian Yacht Squadron saw the successful running of Race 2 and Race 3.

Race 3 was windward / leeward course with two return laps at 200 degrees and the distance of 1 nautical mile. Weather conditions were ideal for F15 racing. The wind was warm at 10 to 12 knots with a moderate swell. All boats got clear start with no recalls. As the race

progressed the fleet gradually spread out. First to round the lee mark were Glamour Buoys (Greg Leaversuch, RFBYC), Firefly (Philippa Packer, RFBYC) and Tuffan Up (David Yu, RFBYC). The wind gradually dropped during the race causing the fleet to further separate. First, second and third places went to Glamour Buoys (Greg Leaversuch, RFBYC), Firefly (Philippa Packer, RFBYC) and Tuffan Up (David Yu, RFBYC). A protest was lodged during the race which resulted in a disqualification to Faffin (Carl Pettersson, SoPYCF). 22 The course for Race 4 was a loop, triangle, loop. The wind had gone around to 210 degrees and dropped to about 9 knots. A number of yachts were a little too eager get a good start and a general call resulted. All yachts were better behaved for the second start. Fforeigner (Simon Lucas, PRSC) had to withdraw after breaking a spreader. The first yachts to round

the first lee mark were Ineffable (Nick Jerwood, SOPYC), Tuffan Up (David Yu, RFBYC) and Ark (David Tabb). These boats maintained the positions the second time around the lee mark. The breeze increased to about 13 knots and causing a few position changes. On the podium for Race 4 were Ineffable (Nick Jerwood, SOPYC) first, Tuffan Up (David Yu, RFBYC) second and Firefly (Philippa Packer, RFBYC) third.

Nine races were completed over a 5 day regatta at the Flying 15 Australian National Championships held at the Royal South Australian Yacht Squadron.

Nick and Enfys Jerwood, from the South of Perth Yacht Club, dominated the regatta with 4 first placings and 3 second placings.

The final top 4 places in the Australian National Championships were:

- 1. Ineffable Nick and Enfys Jerwood South of Perth Yacht Club
- 2. Firefly Philippa Packer and Dean McAullay Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club Perth
- 3. Tuffan Up David Yu and Chris Nelson Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club Perth
- 4. Glamour Buoys- Greg Leaversuch and Peter Barblett Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club Perth



The Performance Handicap trophy for the series was won by Ffast Lane 3 helmed by John Wilson.

Racing was abandoned on the 4thday of the regatta due to strong winds. A call was made early in the day and skippers and crew were given the day off for sightseeing and relaxation.

Three races were run on the final day of the regatta. These included a mixture of sausage and triangle courses. Conditions were pleasant with 12 – 14 kts but the water remained choppy

from the strong winds the day before. Races 7 and 8 were won by Ineffable (Nick and Enfys Jerwood) and, as they had already sealed the championship win, they decided to sit out the last race.

This regatta saw the introduction of the inaugural Matt Owen Trophy for the highest placed female in the Australian Championships. This was won by Enfys Jerwood as crew on



Ineffable. Runner up was Phillipa Packer who helmed Firefly.

An Invitational Race was held on Day 1 of the regatta in the sheltered Port River due to 20 - 22 kt wind conditions. The Uffa Fox Trophy for this race was won by Glamour Buoys(Greg Leaversuch and Peter Barblett, RFBYC).

First place in the division for old Classic boats was won by Scallywag (Marc Read, Christies Sailing Club).

Presentations were held in the prestigious

upstairs dining room at the Royal South Australian Yacht Squadron.
