



Preliminary Advice of the 59th International Flying Fifteen 2021 Australian National Championship and the 23rd International Flying Fifteen 2021 World Championship (“the Events”)

The Events are to be conducted in the waters off Fremantle, Western Australia between 5 and 19 February 2021 by the Organising Authority, Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club Inc (RFBYC) in conjunction with Flying Fifteen International Australia Inc (FFIA) and Flying Fifteen International Inc (FFI).

The Venue Partner Club for the Events is the Fremantle Sailing Club Inc, located at 151 Marine Terrace, Fremantle.

Over the years, the Organising Authority and the Venue Partner Club have organised and conducted numerous similar World and National Championship events. They have developed a wealth of skills, knowledge and experience from which to draw upon to ensure the success of the Events to be conducted in February 2021.

During the month of February, the average daily maximum temperature is 31.7 degrees celsius and minimum 18.3 degrees celsius. The ocean conditions present a low wave ‘chop’ on a mild swell. Generally, the mornings experience easterly land breezes varying between 5 to 15 knots, a breeze that is most often replaced by the famous ‘Fremantle Doctor’, a cooling south westerly sea breeze that ranges in strength between 10 and 20 knots.

This sailing arena is only a short sail from the facilities of the Venue Partner Club and will provide competitors with level and fair sailing conditions, with the wind directions, wind patterns and wave conditions providing a fair test of sailing abilities.

The Organising Committee looks forward to welcoming you to Perth, Fremantle and Western Australia for a great time both on and off the water. It is not all about the sailing with so many other activities and things to do on a visit to Western Australia.
