A Fleet is building up in NSW current plans are to kick off sailing on the 9th of September with a series of eight regattas to be held between September and Christmas from Botany Bay Yacht Club. The intention is to use shared boats initially to get as many people sailing as possible. Botany Bay Yacht Club's fleet will initially be comprise mainly of older 15s available in NSW though there will be at least one "modern" 15. It is hoped to conduct a New South Wales State Championship at the Twofold Bay Regatta in mid-February 2013 and entries from other State/Territory associations will be welcome. In addition to BBYC, there is some interest from other clubs. As you are aware FFIA are already planning towards conducting the 2014 Australian Championship in conjunction with Lake Macquarie Yacht Club. Hopefully interest in the BBYC fleet and the 2014 Australian Championship will
